

# Arabic Fruit Names Matching Games

- Print off the fruit name pages. Depending on what version you want your child to play, you may need to print them off more than once. See the versions below.
- Laminate and cut out the cards.

## **Game Version One:**

Print out two of each picture card. Lay down the cards (perhaps just a few at a time, with their matching card) and have your child match the pictures together. To reinforce the name of the fruit, each time tell your child the name. When your child learns the names, have your child name the cards when they turn them over. If they make a match you can either let them win the match and set it aside or make it a rule that your child must properly name the fruit before “winning” a match.

## **Game Version Two:**

To reinforce not only learning the names of the fruit, but also recognition of that name in print, you can use this version of the game.

Print out a copy of each page and laminate. Give your child the cards and have your child match the written name with the fruit picture card.

Once your child is aware of print, you can always have your child also match the name cards themselves.

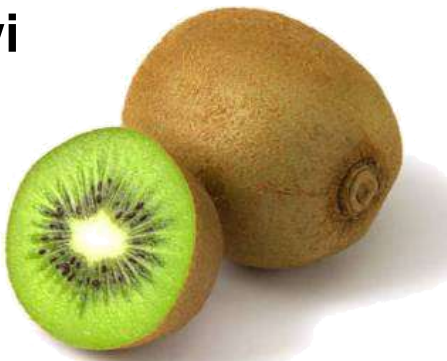

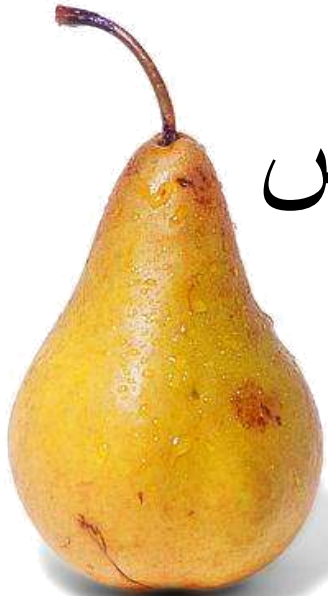
